

## **Scott Ellington Memorial Scholarship**

The Department of Biology of New Mexico State University announces the availability of an \$800 Scott Ellington Memorial scholarship for the 2008-2009 academic year to be awarded to a junior or senior Biology major with a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Scott was a native of Las Cruces and the son of a NMSU faculty member. He was a senior biology student at the University of New Mexico when he was diagnosed with cancer. He lost his battle with the disease in 1994 and this scholarship was established by his family.
